Our Sunday Gospel invites us to look very carefully at how society tries to convince us that to get and to accumulate more is better than to have less. Consequently, we draw conclusions that we will be a better person if we have the best and the most popular style. As a result, we take little things for granted. I believe that we may even put ourselves down as second-class people because we are not able to impress others.

Also, our Gospel reminds us that little things count. Heroic deeds may impress us, but we should also be impressed by the ordinary firemen risking and even giving their lives to rescue people trapped in the debris of any building or house; the doctors and health care people's hard work during this pandemic period; the heroic disposition of our children to stay home mostly all day long; hardworking parents who make little sacrifices every day to provide a good education for their children; the housekeeper who wants to keep the halls of an apartment building spotlessly clean; the teachers and catechist who many times in their life volunteer to help our children to learn and to live the gospel values; the modest paid gardener who takes good care of the lawn and the flowers in the garden. As Christians we must keep in mind that little things are the building blocks of greater things. Finally, as believers we realize that the love of God always is in our daily, ordinary life and not an extraordinary event.




