Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The experience of Jesus in Matthew's Gospel emphasizes and reminds us of the cost of discipleship. We hear a very patient Jesus who explains to his friends the inevitability of the Paschal Mystery, particularly the cross. We hear Peter who could not reconcile the reality that Jesus (the perceived Messiah) would not be able to liberate his people from Rome's dominion. He also could not accept the Cross as an essential mark of true Jesus followers. As Christians, we realize that God desires new life and promises us a continued love and presence in our journey.

As we end the month of August and begin September, our parish programs used to begin. This year we offer the following programs: RCIA in Spanish and English, and Religion Education. These two programs are open to our community online and probably some meetings throughout this first semester. We keep praying for all people in hospitals battling against COVID – 19, for first responders, all our health system people and for the families and children who crossed the USA borders and for all victims of violence on our streets.

La experiencia de Jesús en el Evangelio de Mateo enfatiza y nos recuerda del costo de ser un discípulo. Escuchamos a un muy paciente Jesús quien explica a sus amigos la inevitabilidad del Misterio Pascal, particularmente la cruz. Escuchamos a Pedro quien no puede reconciliar la realidad que Jesús (el percibido Mesías) no puede liberar a su gente del dominio de Roma. Tampoco puede aceptar la cruz como una marca esencial de verdaderos seguidores de Jesús. Como Cristianos, nos damos cuenta que Dios desea nueva vida y nos promete una amor perdurante y presencia en nuestra jornada.

Al terminar el mes de Agosto y comenzar el mes de Septiembre, muchos de nuestros programas parroquiales solían comenzar. Nuestra parroquia, Inmaculado Corazon de Maria ofrece los siguientes programas este año: RICA (Rito de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos), Educación Religiosa para nuestros niños. Estos dos programas están abiertos a nuestra comunidad en línea y probablemente algunas reuniones a lo largo de este primer semestre. Seguimos orando por todas las personas hospitalizadas que luchan contra COVID – 19, todas las personas de nuestro sistema de salud y por las familias y los niños que cruzaron la fronteras de los Estados Unidos y por todas las víctimas de la violencia en nuestras calles.
