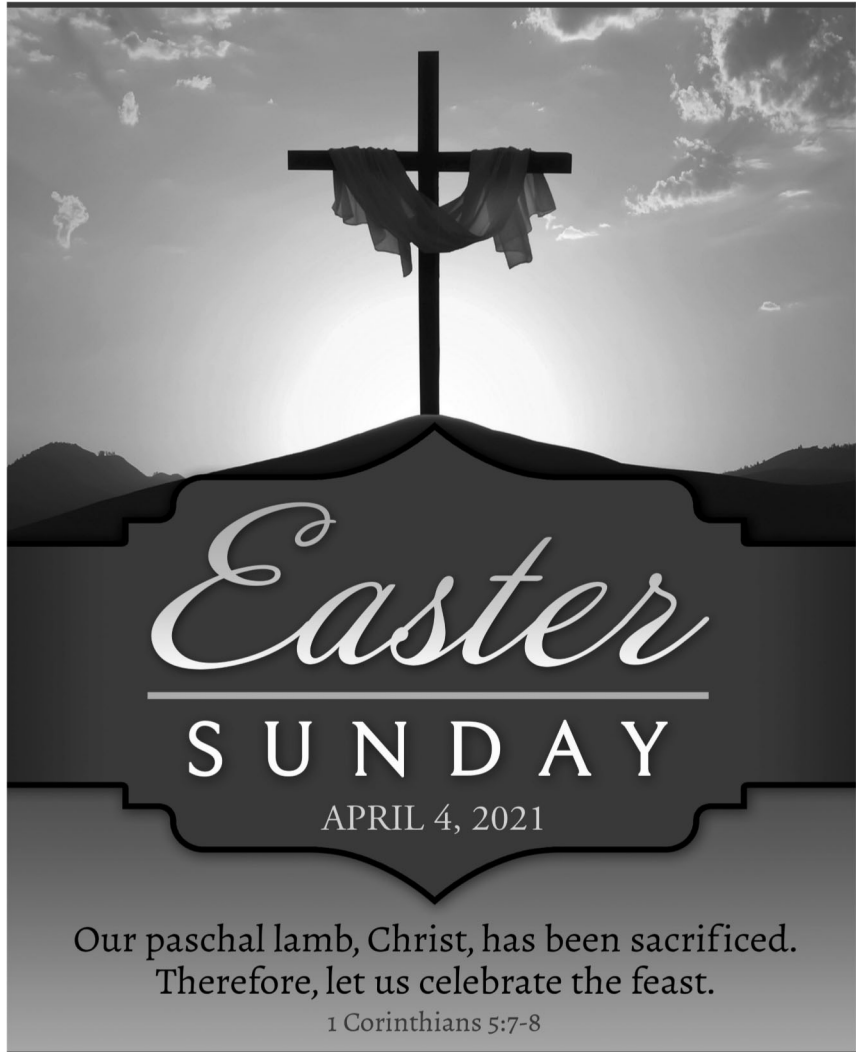

Why is it then important for us to hope? It is for the simple reason that no matter how helpless or confused we are, we are to hang on to the promise of

Because they have taken away my Lord...



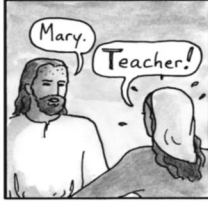
Woman, why are you weeping? Whom do you seek?
