6. WHAT'S THE BIG DEAL: LEAVING MASS IMMEDIATELY AFTER RECEIVING COMMUNION

While not as bad as missing Mass, leaving Mass immediately after receiving Holy Communion is still very disrespectful to your spouse. Again, let's use the analogy of Jesus as the Bridegroom and the Church as his spouse. Leaving immediately after receiving Holy Communion, screams that you really do not understand what has just happened. You have just received the God of the Universe, the One who created you, the One who died on the cross for you, the Eternal, the Almighty God into your heart and soul and you don't even stop to say "thank you" to your spouse. You cannot have a deep personal intimate relationship with the one who loves you more than you'll ever know, if you leave as soon as YOU get what YOU want...people do not reverence the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ. **Do they not know that after Holy Communion, they are a walking tabernacle?** What can be so important that one would not spend a few moments in thanksgiving for receiving the Almighty God into your very being?

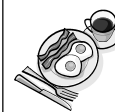


SANCTUARY LIGHT
