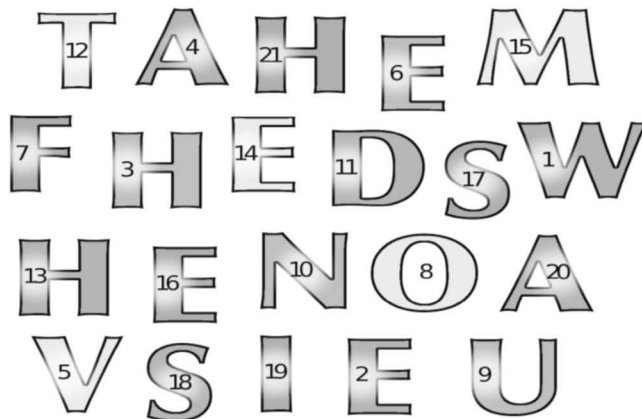
Samuel grew up, and the Lord was with him, not permitting any word of his to be without effect.

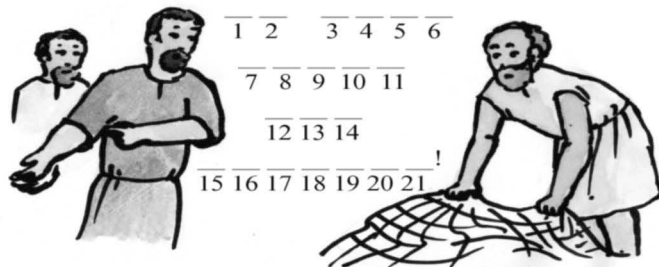
