

**Dear Brothers and Sisters,**

The reading of the Passion marks the beginning of the most significant week in our annual Christian Journey. It will lead us from the joyful entry of Jesus into Jerusalem, through his passion and death, to the resurrection of Easter. We enter Holy Week with St. Matthew's Gospel highlighting how much Jesus loves life and how intensely he loves others. For the sake of others, he was willing to give over his own life. He healed, comforted, forgave and instilled hope in others. We also are to give our lives over for others. We commit ourselves to be especially aware of those around us in need.

However, this Holy Week is not intended to simply be like past holy weeks. We are called to embrace this Holy Week with our whole humanness. We are called to embrace the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus as unique, and as our own experience of faith in this time of crisis.

This Holy Week is not going to be celebrated in a large congregation of our parochial community as usual, but it is a personal invitation to become engaged in Jesus' journey and to make connections with our own journey in our heart, mind, and soul. This holy week gives each one of us the chance to meet Jesus in the deepest and personal way of our life, our own silence. This Holy Week also gives us the chance to reconnect, to refresh and to overcome any family issue and become stronger families through the grace and mercy of our Lord.

As a community with a profound faith in our Lord, we continue to pray for all of you involved in the medical care of all the sick, all of you who work serving the public, and those who are promoting the prevention of the spread of the coronavirus, you be safe.



# Holy Week

Did you know that this week is the most important one in the whole year? Holy Week has Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. On these days we remember and celebrate the most important things that Jesus did before His resurrection on Easter Sunday.

On Holy Thursday Jesus said the first Mass and made his apostles the first priests. Go to Mass on Thursday if you can, and think about what Jesus did- He made bread and wine into Himself so that He could still be with us after He went back into Heaven.

On Good Friday Jesus suffered terribly and then died on the cross because of our sins. He offered up His life, even though He had never sinned, so that all of us could go to Heaven. That's why we call it "Good" Friday. Can you offer some sacrifice to Jesus in return for what He did for you?

On Holy Saturday Jesus' body was in the tomb. His friends were all shocked by what had happened and were afraid and sad. They did not remember what was going to happen next... Do you remember what happened after Holy Saturday?
