DEAR PARISHIONERS / QUERIDOS PARROQUIANOS

As many of you might have already heard and/or seen, on March 23, 2020 Mayor Ron Nirenberg of San Antonio issued a Declaration of Public Health Emergency Regarding Covid-19. He stated that all non-essential businesses shut down and for all persons to remain in their homes. Immaculate Heart of Mary Church is not exempt from this order. It is with a heavy heart that I must now close the doors to Immaculate Heart of Mary Church as well as the Parish office. This will take place immediately and will stay in place until April 9, 2020 or until the City of San Antonio removes this order. The Parish staff (will be working from home) answering the phones Monday-Friday from 9:00 am-1:00 pm if you have any questions. Remember that we are all in this together and I am with you as we face this crisis. Let us pray for the health and safety of our great nation as we hope and wait to overcome COVID-19.
